**Title of Bill:** Supplemental Appropriation – Fund Balance –Roads and Bridges Capital Budget-  
Belvidere Road

**Synopsis:** A Bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, in order to appropriate expenditure authority within the Roads and Bridges Capital Projects Budget in the amount of \$750,000 from the General Fund – Assignment of Fund Balance.

**Supplemental Appropriation – Fund Balance – Roads and Bridges Capital Budget – Belvidere Road**

1           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2021, the  
2 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2022; and  
3           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held  
4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2022; and  
5           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 1, 2021, the  
6 Budget for Cecil County was approved for Fiscal Year 2022; and  
7           **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2022 revenue estimate within the Roads  
8 and Bridges Capital Projects Fund by \$750,000 to allow the following appropriation within the Capital  
9 Projects Fund: the addition of \$750,000 in expenditures to complete the design and engineering for the  
10 road “gap” between the bridge project and the interchange project on Belvidere Road. The necessary  
11 road improvements to connect the projects is currently not funded within the bridge replacement project  
12 or the interchange project. The County Executive has assigned fund balance to carry forward the funds to  
13 pay for the equipment once received; and  
14           **WHEREAS**, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$750,000 of the County Executive’s FY2021  
15 assigned fund balance of the General Fund for expenditures on Belvidere Road to be transferred to the  
16 Capital Projects Fund.  
17           **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**  
18 **MARYLAND**, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal  
19 Year 2022 is amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Budget to appropriate  
20 expenditure authority within the Roads and Bridges Capital Projects Budget in the amount of \$750,000  
21 from the General Fund – Assignment of Fund Balance.  
22           **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that this Bill  
23 shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date that it becomes law.
