WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2021, the 1 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2022; and 2 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 3 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2022; and 4 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 1, 2021, the 5 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2022; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2022 Special Revenue Other Grants 8 Fund – Office of Economic Development revenue estimate for Cecil County to establish the following 9 amount: the addition of \$27,000 in grant revenue and expense to the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund 10 - Office of Economic Development budget to provide for the grant from the Upper Shore Regional Council 11 awarded to Cecil County; and 12 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$27,000 in program funding to allow for an 13 Agriculture Microgrant Program, specifically designed to help between ten and thirty Cecil County agricultural enterprises with projects to start, expand, diversify or market their business or projects, which 14

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

SPONSOR: Council President at the request of the County Executive

RESOLUTION NO. 61-2021 – Supplemental Appropriation – Grant Funds – Economic Development – Upper Shore Regional Council – Agriculture Microgrant Program

SYNOPSIS: A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, in order to provide a total of \$27,000 to the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund- Office of Economic Development, in order to record the grant awarded from the Upper Shore Regional Council, for the purpose of an Agriculture Microgrant Program in Cecil County.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: Net fiscal impact to the County will be zero for Fiscal 2022. The Upper Shore Regional Council has awarded Cecil County \$27,000 to allow for a micro-ag grant program.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The addition of \$27,000 in grant revenue and expense within the Special Revenue-Other Grant's Fund from the Upper Shore Regional Council will fund an Agriculture Microgrant Program in Cecil County. The Upper Shore Agriculture Microgrant Program is a collaborative effort between the three upper shore counties; Cecil, Kent and Queen Anne's. This program will encourage the collaboration of farmers and agricultural enterprises in the upper shore region to work together to promote the buy local movement, improve access to food, help alleviate food insecurity, and fund projects that feed, fuel and clothe our regional community. The focus of the program is to improve our regional food system by creating a cohesive relationship between the economic development offices and farmers within the upper shore region. The micro grant program will enhance access to fresh food in our rural communities while opening doors to resource sharing and partnerships throughout the upper shore, ultimately helping to create a vibrant and economically sustainable rural community.
