SYNOPSIS: A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to provide a total of \$87,500 to the Solid Waste Management Division – Department of Public Works, to record grant funding from the Maryland Environmental Service to be used to cover costs associated with conducting an agricultural tire collection event.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY</u>: Net fiscal impact to the County will be zero for Fiscal 2022. The grant funding will have offsetting expenses.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The addition of \$87,500 in grant revenue and expense within the Solid Waste Management Division – Department of Public Works from the Maryland Environmental Service will fund an agricultural tire collection event to be held at the Cecil County Central Landfill.
