Title of Resolution: Charter Amendment – Vacancy in the Office of County Executive

Synopsis: A Resolution amending Article 4, Executive, Section 407, Vacancy in the Office of County Executive, of the Cecil County Charter to provide that the Council has thirty days after receiving a list of nominees from the county central committee of the political party affiliated with the person vacating the office, to fill the County Executive vacancy. To require submission of this amendment to the legally qualified voters of Cecil County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with Section 602 of the Charter of Cecil County

1	WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter, the Charter		
2	may be amended by the procedures provided in Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution; and		
3	WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, amendments to		
4	any charter adopted by any County of this State under the provisions of this Article may be		
5	proposed by a resolution of the Council of the County, or by a petition signed by not less than		
6	20% of the registered voters of the City or County, provided, however, that in any case 10,000		
7	signatures shall be sufficient to complete a petition; and		
8	WHEREAS, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(a)(iii) and §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election		
9	Law Article, the Attorney, designated to represent the county legislative body, shall prepare		
10	and certify, and submit to the State Board of Election, not later than August 5, 2022, the		
11	following information as required under §7-103(b) of the Election Law Article for each question		
12	to be voted on in the County: (1) a question number or letter as by the Election Board; (2) a		
13	brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3) a brief descriptive title in boldface		
14	type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the question; and (5) the voting choices that		
15	the voter has; and		
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and		
17	Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the		
18	President of the County Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in		
19	least one newspaper published in said County; and		
20	WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and		
21	Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, an amendment so proposed shall be submitted to		
22	the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election occurring after the		
23	passage of the resolution; and		
24	WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and		
25	Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for		
26	the amendment shall be in favor thereof, the amendment shall be adopted and become a part		
27	of the charter of the County from and after the thirtieth day after said election; and		
28	WHEREAS, Article 4, Executive, Section 407, Vacancy in the Office of County Executive,		
29	of the Cecil County Charter currently provides that:		

30	"A vacancy in the Office of the Executive shall exist upon the death or resignation of the		
31	Executive, or upon forfeiture of office as provided in Section 408 of this Charter. A majority of		
32	the council members shall appoint, within thirty days, a person to fill the vacancy. An		
33	appointee, when succeeding a party member, shall be a member of the same political party as		
34	the person elected to such office and shall be a nominee of the County central committee of		
35	that party. Any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall meet the qualifications provided in		
36	Section 405 of this Charter.", and		
37	WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and		
38	Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, this Resolution proposes the following		
39	amendment to Article 4, Executive, Section 407, Vacancy in the Office of County Executive, of		
40	the Cecil County Charter:		
41	"A vacancy in the Office of the Executive shall exist upon the death or resignation of the		
42	Executive, or upon forfeiture of office as provided in Section 408 of this Charter. A majority of		
43	the council members shall appoint, within thirty days AFTER RECEIVING A LIST OF THREE		
44	NOMINEES FROM THE LOCAL CENTRAL COMMITTEE, a person to fill the vacancy. An		
45	appointee, when succeeding a party member, shall be a member of the same political party as		
46	the person elected to such officeand shall be a nominee of The County central committee		
47	of that party SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF THREE NOMINEES WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF THE		
48	VACANCY TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL. Any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall meet the		
49	qualifications provided in Section 405 of this Charter."		
50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL		
51	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the following amendment to Article 4, Executive, Section 407,		
52	Vacancy in the Office of County Executive, of the Cecil County Charter, shall be submitted to the		
53	voters of the County at the next general or congressional election in accordance with Article 6,		
54	Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution:		
55	"A vacancy in the Office of the Executive shall exist upon the death or resignation of the		
56	Executive, or upon forfeiture of office as provided in Section 408 of this Charter. A majority of		
57	the council members shall appoint, within thirty days AFTER RECEIVING A LIST OF THREE		

NOMINEES FROM THE LOCAL CENTRAL COMMITTEE, a person to fill the vacancy. An

appointee, when succeeding a party member, shall be a member of the same political party as the person elected to such office. **and shall be a nominee of** The County central committee of that party **SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF THREE NOMINEES WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF THE VACANCY TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL.** Any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall meet the qualifications provided in Section 405 of this Charter."

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(a)(iii) and §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election Law Article, the Attorney, designated to represent the county legislative body, shall prepare, certify, and submit to the State Board of Election, not later than August 5, 2022, the following information as required under §7-103(b) of the Election Law Article: (1) a question number or letter as by the Election Board; (2) a brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3) a brief descriptive title in boldface type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the question; and (5) the voting choices that the voter has.

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the President of the County Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in at least one newspaper published in said County.

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the aforementioned proposed amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election occurring after the passage of this Resolution.

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for the aforementioned proposed amendment shall be in favor thereof, then the proposed amendment shall be adopted and become a part of the Charter of Cecil County from and after the thirtieth day after said election.
