RESOLUTION NO. 31-2022

Title of Resolution: Charter Amendment – Ethics Commission

Synopsis: A Resolution amending Article 6, Miscellaneous, to add a new Section 607, Ethics Commission, of the Cecil County Charter to re-establish the Ethics Commission as an independent agency with five-voting members, who shall serve a four-year staggered term; three members, including chair, appointed by the Executive; and two members appointed by the Council. To require submission of this amendment to the legally qualified voters of Cecil County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with Section 602 of the Charter of Cecil County.

1 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter, the Charter
2 may be amended by the procedures provided in Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution; and

3 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, amendments to
4 any charter adopted by any County of this State under the provisions of this Article may be
5 proposed by a resolution of the Council of the County, or by a petition signed by not less than
6 20% of the registered voters of the City or County, provided, however, that in any case 10,000
7 signatures shall be sufficient to complete a petition; and

8 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(a)(iii) and §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election
9 Law Article, the Attorney, designated to represent the county legislative body, shall prepare
10 and certify, and submit to the State Board of Election, not later than August 5, 2022, the
11 following information as required under §7-103(b) of the Election Law Article for each question
12 to be voted on in the County: (1) a question number or letter as by the Election Board; (2) a
13 brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3) a brief descriptive title in boldface
14 type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the question; and (5) the voting choices that
15 the voter has; and

16 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and
17 Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the
18 President of the County Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in at
19 least one newspaper published in said County; and

20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and
21 Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, an amendment so proposed shall be submitted to
22 the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election occurring after the
23 passage of the resolution; and

24 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and
25 Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for
26 the amendment shall be in favor thereof, the amendment shall be adopted and become a part
27 of the charter of the County from and after the thirtieth day after said election; and

28 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article
29 XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, this Resolution proposes the following amendment to

30 Article 6, Miscellaneous, Section 607, Ethics Commission, of the Cecil County Charter:

- 31 **“(A) THE CECIL COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION IS AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY OF CECIL**
32 **COUNTY GOVERNMENT.**
- 33 **(B) THE MEMBERS OF THE CECIL COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION ARE VOLUNTEERS AND**
34 **SHALL SERVE A FOUR-YEAR STAGGERED TERM.**
- 35 **(C) THREE OF THE MEMBERS, INCLUDING CHAIR, SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE**
36 **EXECUTIVE; TWO OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL.**
- 37 **(D) THE COUNTY ATTORNEY SHALL ASSIST THE COMMISSION IN CARRYING OUT THE**
38 **COMMISSION’S DUTIES.**
- 39 **(E) IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT OF INTEREST, THE COMMISSION MAY ENGAGE**
40 **INDEPENDENT LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONFLICT, TO BE PAID BY**
41 **THE COUNTY.”**

42 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL**
43 **COUNTY, MARYLAND,** that the following amendment to Article 6, Miscellaneous, Section 607,
44 Ethics Commission, of the Cecil County Charter, shall be submitted to the voters of the County
45 at the next general or congressional election in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the
46 Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution:

- 47 **“(A) THE CECIL COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION IS AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY OF CECIL**
48 **COUNTY GOVERNMENT.**
- 49 **(B) THE MEMBERS OF THE CECIL COUNTY ETHICS COMMISSION ARE VOLUNTEERS AND**
50 **SHALL SERVE A FOUR-YEAR STAGGERED TERM.**
- 51 **(C) THREE OF THE MEMBERS, INCLUDING CHAIR, SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE**
52 **EXECUTIVE; TWO OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL.**
- 53 **(D) THE COUNTY ATTORNEY SHALL ASSIST THE COMMISSION IN CARRYING OUT THE**
54 **COMMISSION’S DUTIES.**
- 55 **(E) IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT OF INTEREST, THE COMMISSION MAY ENGAGE**
56 **INDEPENDENT LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONFLICT, TO BE PAID BY**
57 **THE COUNTY.”**

58 **AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
59 **MARYLAND,** that, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(a)(iii) and §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election
60 Law Article, the Attorney, designated to represent the county legislative body, shall prepare,
61 certify, and submit to the State Board of Election, not later than August 5, 2022, the following
62 information as required under §7-103(b) of the Election Law Article: (1) a question number or
63 letter as by the Election Board; (2) a brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3)
64 a brief descriptive title in boldface type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the
65 question; and (5) the voting choices that the voter has.

66 **AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
67 **MARYLAND,** that pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A,
68 §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the President of the
69 County Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in at least one
70 newspaper published in said County.

71 **AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
72 **MARYLAND,** that pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A,
73 §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the aforementioned proposed amendment shall be submitted
74 to the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election occurring after the
75 passage of this Resolution.

76 **AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
77 **MARYLAND,** that in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and
78 Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for
79 the aforementioned proposed amendment shall be in favor thereof, then the proposed
80 amendment shall be adopted and become a part of the Charter of Cecil County from and after
81 the thirtieth day after said election.
