1 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2021, the County
2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2022; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held
4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2022; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 01, 2021, the
6 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2022; and


7 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2022 Solid Waste Management Division –
8 Department of Public Works revenue estimate for Cecil County to establish the following amount: the
9 addition of \$17,500 in grant revenue and expense to the Solid Waste Management Division – Department
10 of Public Works budget to provide for a grant from the Maryland Environmental Service to cover costs
11 associated with conducting a Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-Off Day Event.

12 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
13 **MARYLAND**, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for Fiscal
14 Year 2022 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation; and by amending the Current Budget to
15 appropriate \$17,500 in additional expenditures in the Solid Waste Management Division – Department of
16 Public Works budget to record the grant funding from the Maryland Environmental Service.

17 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that this
18 Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

SYNOPSIS: A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to provide a total of \$17,500 to the Solid Waste Management Division – Department of Public Works, to record grant funding from the Maryland Environmental Service to be used to cover costs associated with conducting a Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-Off Day Event.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: Net fiscal impact to the County will be zero for Fiscal 2022. The grant funding will have offsetting expenses.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The addition of \$17,500 in grant revenue and expense within the Solid Waste Management Division – Department of Public Works from the Maryland Environmental Service will fund a Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-Off Day Event to be held at the Cecil County Central Landfill.
