 treatment plants and related facilities; schedules, plans, assigns, and oversees daily operations including,
 facility maintenance and repair, obtains and analyzes samples, fills and maintains chemical feed tanks,
 operates flow meters and other equipment, and processes sludge. Compiles daily, monthly and annual
 reports.
- 2. Operates process control systems; evaluates plant performance from calculations, laboratory data, operational reports, trends, field observations, and other process performance data and makes adjustments to maintain proper levels of treatment and compliance with National Pollution Discharge Elimination System and other permits and regulations.
- 3. Performs preventative maintenance, troubleshoots, and performs and minor repairs to machinery and equipment such as chemical feed systems, sample collection equipment, ultraviolet disinfection systems, and membrane and other filtration systems; coordinates for higher-level maintenance and repair tasks which exceed operator level capabilities.
