Job Summary: Reviews and interprets plans and permits to ensure compliance with all applicable codes and standards; interacts with consultants and developers; prepares cost estimates, performance guarantees, inspection and maintenance agreements; performs on-site inspections of assigned sites as necessary; establishes and maintains accurate files; performs other duties as assigned.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Reviews and interprets plans and permits to ensure compliance with all applicable codes and standards.
- 2. Interacts with consultants and developers as necessary.
- 3. Prepares costs estimates, performance guarantees, inspection and maintenance agreements, and other documents as required.
- 4. Prepares reports or special assignments.
- 5. Performs review function for fast-track and standard project submittals.
- 6. Provides responses to inquiries or complaints from the public.
- 7. Performs on-site inspections of assigned sites as necessary.
- 8. Establishes and maintains accurate and complete files.
- 9. May review subdivision and development plans to assure compliance with regulations and ordinances.
- 10. Performs other duties as instructed and assigned.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- 2. Ability to prepare, review, and interpret engineering drawings, blueprints, maps, and other technical material.

- 7. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships and to work as a member of a team.
