**SYNOPSIS:** A resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to increase revenue and offsetting expenses by \$10,000 for the Office of Economic Development - Tourism.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: Net fiscal impact to the County will be zero for Fiscal 2023.

## **FISCAL ANALYSIS:**

The addition of \$10,000 in revenue to fund "Winter Lights-Cecil Nights" Marketing Campaign designed to promote downtown municipal businesses. The additional \$10,000 in offsetting expenses will be used by Marketing Campaign.
