Supplemental Appropriation – Grant Funds – Community Services – Human Services Division – Food and Supplies

1 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2022, the County
2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

3 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public
4 hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

5 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 7, 2022, the Budget
6 for Cecil County was approved for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

7 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2023 Special Revenue Other Grants Fund
8 – Department of Community Services – Human Services Division revenue estimate Cecil County in order to
9 establish the following amount: the addition of \$15,686 in grant revenue and expense to the Special Revenue
10 Other Grants Fund – Department of Community Services – Human Services Division budget to provide for
11 the grant award from the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program; and

12 **WHEREAS**, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$15,686 in grant funding for food and supplies.

13 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
14 **MARYLAND**, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year
15 ending June 30, 2023 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation; and by amending the Budget
16 in order to appropriate \$15,686 in additional expenditures in the Special Revenue Other Grant Fund –
17 Department of Community Services – Human Services Division, to record the grant awarded from the
18 Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program for the purpose of providing food and supplies.

19 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that this
20 Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.

SYNOPSIS: A resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to increase revenue and offsetting expenses by \$15,986 for the Department of Community Services – Human Services Division.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: Net fiscal impact to the County will be zero for Fiscal 2023.
