WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2022, the County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 8, 2022, the Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2023; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2023 expenditure for Cecil County to increase use of the Assigned Fund Balance for (1) Ambulance for the County \$522,277.84 to allow the following appropriation within the General Fund:

a.) The addition of \$522,277.84 in expenditures for the Department of Emergency Services
Ambulance replacement. Ambulance cost \$368,649, Equipment to upfit ambulance
\$37,568.96, Cardiac monitor \$29,940.56 in which \$10,000 will be received in grant funds
after, (3) three portable radios \$31,119.32 in \$19795.65 was received from insurance, and
bariatric equipment \$55,000; and,

WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$522,277.84 of the County Executive's FY2023 assigned fund balance for the General Fund for expenditures; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal
Year 2023 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Budget
to appropriate \$522,277.84 of additional expenditures from the General Fund to the Department of
Emergency Service's budget.
