WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1321.57(a) of the Older Americans Act of 1965, the area agency
on aging shall establish an advisory council that shall carry out advisory functions that further the area
agency's mission of developing and coordinating community-based systems of services for all older
persons in the planning and service area; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1321.57(a) of the Older Americans Act of 1965, the council shall
include individuals and representatives of community organizations who help to enhance the
leadership role of the area agency in developing community-based systems of service; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 10 Human Services, Section 201 of the Annotated Code of
Maryland, the Maryland Department of Aging was created as a principal executive department to
administer programs mandated by the federal government throughout the state through the Area
Agencies on Aging; and
WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Aging has designated the Senior Services and
Community Transit of Cecil County as the Area Agency on Aging; and
WHEREAS, the Cecil County Commission on Aging oversees the provision of services to seniors
as the advisory council to the Area Agency on Aging in Cecil County; and
WHEREAS, the Commission on Aging identifies, assesses, and advocates for the needs of the
growing older population in Cecil County; encourages the development of services designed to address
those needs; and supports the mission of the Senior Services and Community Transit of Cecil County of
developing and coordinating community-based systems of services for all older adults in the County;
and
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 412(b) of the Charter of Cecil County, except as provided in
subsection 412(c) or prescribed by State law or other provisions, the County Executive shall appoint all
members of boards and commissions and that such membership shall be subject to confirmation by
the Council; and
WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended Denise Hill, Julianne Graham, Lisa Beeman,
Mark Hill, and Jamie McCloskey to fill vacancies to three-year terms, which will each expire on January
31, 2026.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
