Supplemental Appropriation – Grant Funds – Office of Economic Development – Accept Grant from Maryland Department of Commerce, Office of Tourism

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2022, the
County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2023; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2023; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 7, 2022, the Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2023 Special Revenue Other Grants Fund – Office of Economic Development revenue estimate for Cecil County to establish the following amount: the addition of \$250,000 in grant revenue and expense to the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund – Office of Economic Development budget to provide for the marketing of the Maryland 5 Star and to enhance attendance; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland 5 Star is an economic engine for the local and State economy; and WHEREAS, the marketing will encourage visitation and drive economic impact to our region; and

WHEREAS, the International Federation of Equestrian Sports will begin to evaluate this year whether the Maryland 5 Star will become permanent beyond its 5th year; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide marketing, production, promotional support services for current and future advertising, and diversity outreach for competitors; and

WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$250,000 in program funding for the Maryland 5 Star to market and drive attendance through ticket sales. This grant will also encourage and drive the local and State economy and bring together many local and state partners to make the Maryland 5 Star happen.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2023 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Budget to appropriate \$250,000 in additional expenditures in the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund — Office of Economic Development to record the grant awarded from Maryland Department of Commerce, Office of Tourism to market and promote the Maryland 5 Star in Cecil County.
