**Synopsis:** A resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, in order to provide a total of \$166,562 to the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund- Department of Land Use and Development Services to record the grant awarded by the State of Maryland Bay Restoration to connect sanitary sewer systems or replace septic system for county residents.

Supplemental Appropriation-Grant Funds-

1           **WHEREAS**, the State of Maryland has a Bay Restoration Grant Program authorized in COMAR  
2 Title 26, Subtitle 03, Chapter 13 (COMAR 26.03.13); and

3           **WHEREAS**, the Cecil County Department of Land Use and Development Services, Division of  
4 Development Plans Review was engaged by the State of Maryland to administer this program; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Cecil County property owners engage qualified contractors to either connect to  
6 sanitary sewer or have their septic systems replaced with the best available technology. The  
7 contractors will receive reimbursement from the State of Maryland once the work is completed, except  
8 the five properties; and

9           **WHEREAS**, in five cases the State of Maryland awarded the funds to the County to pay the  
10 contractors, totaling \$166,562; and

11           **WHEREAS**, after these five cases, all payments to contractors will be processed and paid by the  
12 State.

13           **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of  
14 its passage by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland.
