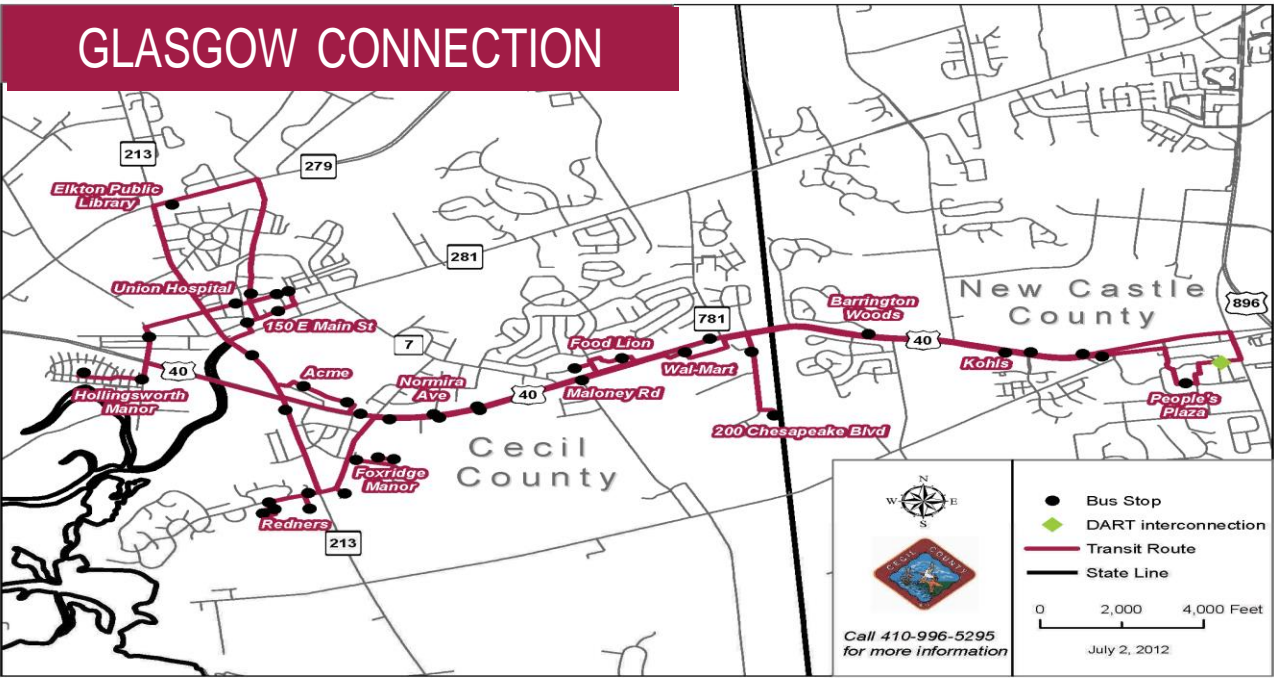

- ### SAFETY RULES

  - ⇒ Do not step in front of the bus at bus stops or any other locations.
  - ⇒ Parents/guardians will assure that children follow all posted safety rules.

\*\*Children under 46" ride free only when accompanied by fare-paying adult; otherwise, regular fare applies. No more than two (2) free children per fare-paying adult.

## HOW TO RIDE THE BUS

- ⇒ Open the schedule and you will find fixed route service time tables. The Glasgow Connection operates Monday - Friday, 5:40am-6:20pm.
- ⇒ Choose where you want to meet the fixed route bus.
- ⇒ Read across for the time when you want to return.
- ⇒ **Bus times are approximate—arrive at bus stop 10 minutes early.**
- ⇒ This schedule may be modified due to inclement weather/mechanical difficulties.
- ⇒ **No service on Major County Holidays**
- ⇒ **For language assistance please call into ur HR Office at (410) 996- 5250**
- ⇒ **Riders must be visible at bus stops.**  
Bus stop signs mark each designated stop along the route. Please stand **IN CLEAR VIEW** of approaching bus and indicate to operator you wish to board.
- ⇒ **Riders must pay upon boarding the bus**  
Please have bus pass or exact change ready when boarding. If riders do not have a bus pass or exact change, they will not be permitted to ride.
- ⇒ **Please make the front seats available to disabled & elderly passengers.**

## ROUTE DEVIATIONS

Deviations up to 3/4 mile may be made upon request. All deviations must be scheduled at least one hour prior to pickup and no more than one business day prior. A total fare of \$4.00 will apply for each deviation. To request a deviation call (410) 996-5295 #2 Monday through Friday 8:00AM to 3:30PM, excluding holidays. Demand Response service may be used in lieu of fixed route service when available.

## ADA

- \*\*Service animals trained to assist an individual in living independently are permitted on board transit vehicles. Pets must be in an industry approved carrier.
- \*\*If a passenger requires modification of any of Cecil Transit policies to accommodate their disability, they may request such a modification by contacting 410-996-5295, Option #2.
- \*\*Flammable/Combustible objects are not allowed to be transported on the buses with exception of respirators, concentrators or portable oxygen tanks for ADA passengers.
