1	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2023, the
2	County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2024; and
3	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council
4	held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year
5	2024; and
6	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 6, 2023,
7	the Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2024; and
8	WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2024 expenditure for Cecil County
9	to increase use of the Unassigned Fund Balance for the purchase of one (1) used ambulance for
10	\$25,000 from the Volunteer Fire Company #1 of Chesapeake City for the transportation of sick and
11	injured citizens; and
12	WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$25,000 of the FY 2024 Unassigned
13	Fund Balance for the General Fund for expenditures.

15	MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for
