- (B) NON-PUBLIC OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL AND SPA AND INDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

 SHALL BE SURROUNDED BY A BARRIER THAT COMPLIES WITH SECTIONS 305.2.1 THROUGH

 305.7.

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- B. IN SECTION 307.1.4, WHERE "INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE" APPEARS, SUBSTITUTE

 "MARYLAND ACCESSIBILITY CODE" AND WHERE "ICC A117.1" APPEARS, SUBSTITUTE

 "MARYLAND ACCESSIBILITY CODE".
- 64 C. IN SECTION 324.7.1 WHERE "INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE" APPEARS, SUBSTITUTE "MARYLAND STATE FIRE PREVENTION CODE".

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND,

that this Act shall take effect in 60 calendar days from the date it becomes law.
