## **Open Meeting Minutes**

April 25, 2023

### **Agenda Approval:**

### **New Business:**

- Lawrence Scott advised the ACC attended and successfully completed training last week and are now certified to hear cases.
- Per Md. Code, Pub., Safety §3-102, Chief Peterson from the Town of Rising Sun Police Department addressed the Board to provide insight into the current trends he is seeing in terms of crime and to discuss policies and procedures of his department. Chief Peterson noted that the department is comprised of himself and 5 officers. He relayed that although recruitment is not easy for a small-town police department, he seeks officers who are interested in community policing to be a good fit for the position and the town. He is slotted for an additional police officer dependent on budget. Chief Peterson advised that his department, in addition to serving the municipality of Rising Sun, also service Conowingo and the Route 1 border corridor, and aid the State Police and Sheriff's department. Chief Peterson advised that a copy of the department policy manual can be found online. He noted recreational use of marijuana becomes legal on July 1, 2023, and expressed concern about the potential impact of PA residents traveling to MD to take advantage of this new law. Probable cause in drug investigations will be disappearing as well as the use of canines in some instances which will also cause an impact. Chief Peterson also expressed great concern regarding impairment and the use of a motor vehicle.
