## **Amendments – Opioid Litigation Trust Fund Agreement**

1	WHEREAS, Cecil County, Maryland initiated litigation in federal court against certain
2	manufacturers and distributers of prescription opioid pharmaceutical products (the "Litigation"); and
3	WHEREAS, the Litigation has resulted in a settlement pursuant to which Cecil County, Maryland
4	has and will continue to receive monetary disbursements (the "Settlement Funds") from the
5	manufacturers and distributers who are defendants in the Litigation to address the impacts directly
6	and proximately related to the opioid epidemic; and
7	WHEREAS, Cecil County, Maryland authorized the establishment of a trust fund in order to
8	invest the Settlement Funds and to authorize the trustees of the trust fund to invest and manage the
9	assets of the trust fund as provided; and
10	WHEREAS, Cecil County, Maryland (the "County") authorized the establishment of the "Cecil
11	County, Maryland Opioid Litigation Settlement Trust Fund" (the "Trust Fund"), under the terms and
12	conditions set forth in a trust agreement to be entered into by the County and the trustees of the fund,
13	substantially in the form of the Cecil County, Maryland Opioid Litigation Settlement Trust Agreement,
14	attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Trust Agreement" – original with proposed amendments); and
15	WHEREAS, the Trust Agreement and the provisions therein regarding the administration of the
16	Trust Fund were approved on October 27, 2020; and
17	WHEREAS, the purpose of the Trust Fund was to preserve and protect the Trust Fund's Assets
18	and to assist the County in providing and supporting programs that educate, prevent, and treat opioid
19	addiction in Cecil County, Maryland; and
20	WHEREAS, the Trustees have been granted full power and authority to invest and manage the
21	assets of the Trust Fund in accordance with the Trust Agreement; and
22	WHEREAS, Neither the establishment of the Trust Fund nor the establishment or maintenance
23	of a reserve to provide for opioid education, prevention, or treatment utilizing Litigation settlement
24	proceeds shall be construed as creating or evidencing an obligation on the County's part to maintain or
25	continue its practice of providing such programs or services; rather, the County expressly reserves the
26	right to alter, amend, modify, or terminate any program or service funded by Trust Fund Assets; and
27	WHEREAS, As set forth in Section 7.02 of the original Trust Agreement (Section 8.02 of Exhibit B
28	as proposed to be amended), the Trust Agreement may be amended by a proposal of the County
29	Executive, after such amendment has been approved by the vote of 2/3 of the Trustees, and approved
30	by the County Council; and
