WHEREAS, according to the Maryland Police Accountability Act of 2021, each county is to have
a Police Accountability Board (PAB) to receive, report, review, investigate and adjudicate complaints of
police misconduct filed by members of the public, pursuant to Section 3-102(a)(3), of the Annotated
Code of Maryland; and
WHEREAS, according to the Cecil County Code Section 82-2 and 82-3, appointed members of
the Cecil County PAB must meet certain qualifications; and
WHEREAS, the PAB appointed members, to the extent practicable, shall reflect the racial,
gender and cultural diversity of the County; and
WHEREAS, the PAB appointed members cannot be an active police officer or retired as a police
officer for less than two years or be a family member of an active police officer or recently retired (less
than two years) police officer, nor can they be an employee of Cecil Government nor an employee of
Cecil County municipality that has a police department; and
WHEREAS, the PAB appointed members must be at least 21 years old and not convicted of state
or federal crime punishable by imprisonment exceeding 1 year (unless pardoned); and
WHEREAS, the PAB appointed members shall comprehend spoken English, comprehend written
English, read English and write English proficiently and pass background checks, including a criminal
background check; and
WHEREAS, the appointed PAB members must be residents of at least 6 months of Cecil County;
and
WHEREAS, Article 4, Section 412 (b) of the charter of Cecil County provides, except as provided
on Section 412(c) or prescribed by State law or other provisions, that the County Executive shall
appoint all members of boards and commissions, subject to confirmation by the Council; and
WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended Cynthia Emmerich to complete John
Stricklett's term for appointment to the PAB, which is to expire on December 31, 2024.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
MARYLAND confirms the recommendation by the County Executive of Cynthia Emmerich to complete
John Stricklett's term for appointment to the PAB, which is to expire on December 31, 2024.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage
by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland.
