8	solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community
9	Development Block Grant Program; and
LO	WHEREAS, Cecil County is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland Community Development Block

12	WHEREAS, the Department of Community Services, representing Cecil County, has been authorized to
l3	apply for up to \$723,000 in grant funds to support the expansion of the Cecil County Child Advocacy Center; and
