WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2023, the County 1 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2024; and 2 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public 3 hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2024; and 4 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 6, 2023, the Budget 5 for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2024; and 6 WHEREAS, the additional funding is requested for the remaining quarter of FY24 due to more than 7 expected repairs and maintenance of aging landfill heavy equipment and roads dump trucks; and 8 WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$250,000 will be provided from the General Fund Unassigned 9 Fund Balance to the Motor Vehicle Internal Service Fund for repairs and maintenance costs for the remainder 10 of FY24. 11 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 12 MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for Fiscal Year 13 2024 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$250,000 from the General 14 Fund Balance to the Motor Vehicle Internal Service Fund for repairs and maintenance costs. 15 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage by the 16 County Council of Cecil County, Maryland. 17
