1	WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of Maryland to regulate and control the manufacture, sale,
2	distribution, transportation and storage of alcoholic beverages within the State, pursuant to Section 1-
3	101(b), Title 1, Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and
4	WHEREAS, it is also the policy of the State to authorize the power and authority to limit
5	economic competition by regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages in order to obtain respect and
6	obedience to law, to foster and promote temperance, to prevent deceptive business practices, and to
7	promote the general welfare of its citizens by controlling the sale and distribution of alcoholic
8	beverages; and
9	WHEREAS, the State authorizes the Board of License Commissioners of each county and
LO	Baltimore City by regulation to limit and restrict, in accordance with a definite standard, the number of
l1	licenses which they consider sufficient for any neighborhood, pursuant to Section 9-201, Title 9, Article
L2	2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and
L3	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Board of License Commissioners shall issue all retail alcoholic
L4	beverage licenses authorized under the State Alcoholic Beverage Article 2B, pursuant to Section 15-
L5	12(i); and
L6	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Board of License Commissioners may employee inspectors to
L7	investigate applicants or transfers for alcoholic beverage licenses, enforce all alcoholic beverage laws
L8	and investigate all violations and report them to the board, pursuant to Section 15-122(i); and
L9	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Board of License Commissioners is comprised of three members
20	who are to be of high moral character, possess sound reputations of integrity, pursuant to Section 15-
21	104(a-1) of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and
22	WHEREAS, Article 4, Section 412 (b) of the Charter of Cecil County, except as provided in
23	Section 412(c) or prescribed by State law or other provisions, that the County Executive shall appoint
24	all members of boards and commissions and that such membership shall be subject to confirmation by
25	the Council; and
26	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the reappointment of Kristin Ortt to the
27	Board of License Commissioners of Cecil County, for a three-year term to expire on June 30, 2027.
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Council of Cecil County confirms
29	the reappointment by the County Executive of Kristin Ortt to the Board of License Commissioners of

Cecil County, for a three-year term to expire on June 30, 2027.
