Title of Bill: Supplemental Appropriation – Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2025 – Fiscal Year 2029 Capital Improvement Program – Expand Port Deposit WWTP, Project Number 55079

Synopsis: A Bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, to provide supplemental expenditure authority from the bond Fund for the Expand Port Deposit WWTP project, Project Number 55079 in the amount of \$8,750,000. The Port Deposit WWTP needs to be expanded to provide additional capacity in support of future development at Bainbridge. The approved capacity will increase from 250,000 Gallons per Day (GPD) to a maximum of 750,000 GPD. Project cost in FY25 and FY26 is \$8,750,000; the County will pay half of the remaining project cost (\$4,375,000) with Bainbridge developer and/or firms(s) contributing the other half of the project construction cost.

Supplemental Appropriation – Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2025 – Fiscal Year 2029 Capital Improvement Program – Expand Port Deposit WWTP - Project Number 55079

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2024, the County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 04, 2024, the Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, Section 511 of the Charter of Cecil County allows the County Council to make supplemental appropriations from revenues in excess of budget estimates or from sources not anticipated in the budget; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting to provide supplemental expenditure authority in the amount of \$8,750,000 to the Expand Port Deposit WWTP capital project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for Fiscal Year 2025 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation; and by amending the Capital Budget to appropriate \$4,375,000 for the Expand Port Deposit WWTP capital project budget and by replacing the Expand Port Deposit WWTP Project Form in the Fiscal Year 2025 – Fiscal Year 2029 Capital Improvement Budget with Attachment 1.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that this Bill shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date that it becomes law.
