easements by the Foundation within the county, to	review the status of agricultural districts and land under
easement, to advise the Foundation concerning cou	inty priorities for agricultural preservation, to approve
applications by the county for certification, to prom	ote preservation of agriculture within the county; and to meet
at least annually with forest conservation district bo	pards in order to work cooperatively to encourage the
promotion and retention of farmland and woodland	d in their jurisdictions; and
WHEREAS, Article 4, Section 412 (b) of the G	Charter of Cecil County provides, except as provided in Section
412(c) or prescribed by State law or other provision	s, that the County Executive shall appoint all members of boards
and commissions, subject to confirmation by the Co	ouncil; and
WHEREAS, the County Executive approves t	the appointment of Clay Stubbs who will be replacing Norman
Anderson, with a term to expire on August 1, 2029,	and Brandon Van Bibber who will replace Shelley Hastings, with
