
How does Cecil County compare to other Maryland counties?

- Highest Growth Rate
 2020 2023: 7th (1.9%)
- Most Populous: 12th (105,672)
- Domestic Migration: 3rd (854)





Income

- Median Household Income: 13th (\$84,513)
- Median Household Income % of Change 2000 - 2022: 19th (66.9%)
- **Per Capita Income:** 13th (\$56,050)

Economic Growth

- **GDP in 2022:** 13th
- % Change in GDP 2021 to 2022: 2nd (3.2%)

- Bachelor's Degree or higher % of Adults 25+: 17th (26.85)
- H.S. Grad or Equivalent: 11th (26,216)
- Bachelor's Degree: 13th (11,804)
- **Graduate or Doctorate Degree:** 14th (7,512)



Jobs

- Average Wage per Job: 10th (\$56,662)
- Average Wage per Manufacturing Job: 5th (\$81,601)
