1	WHEREAS, Division I, Title 8, Subtitle 1, §8-104 et seq. of the Land Use Article, Annotated Code of
2	Maryland authorizes the County to establish regulations and procedures to designate a property as a
3	historic district; and
4	WHEREAS, Article XI, Part IV, Historic District of the Cecil County Zoning Ordinance provides the
5	regulations and procedures to preserve historic districts, landmarks, sites, or structures of historical,
6	archeological, or architectural significance, with their appurtenances and environmental settings, for the
7	public welfare of the residents of Cecil County: and
8	WHEREAS, the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, approved the designation of Keiffer
9	Brick House, located at One Old Farm House Road, Elkton, MD, District 3, Tax Map 309, Parcel 444 on June
10	17, 2014; and
11	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-7. Credit granted, under Article III. Historic Property Tax Credit,
12	Chapter 337 Taxation. of the Code of Cecil County, a property tax of up to 10% of the properly documented
13	expenses of a private owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of a structure that Cecil County
14	determines has historical value may be granted against the County property tax imposed; and
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-9, a property credit granted in one year under this article shall
16	only be applied against the current year's property tax; and the amount of property tax credit to be granted
17	shall not exceed the amount of property tax payable against said property in the year that the tax credit is
18	granted; and credit; and
19	WHEREAS, Patricia Doyle Folk and Edgar Folk III, MD, are the owners of the property at One Old
20	Farm House Road, Elkton, Maryland, also known as Keiffer Brick House; and
21	WHEREAS, Section 337-7 provides a property tax credit of up to 10% of the properly documented
22	expense of the owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of the said parcel; and
23	WHEREAS, Patricia Doyle Folk and Edgar Folk III, MD have presented properly documented receipts
24	in the amount of \$24,214 for restoration and preservation to Keiffer Brick House, which has been reviewed
25	and recommended by the Historic District Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Real Property Tax bill for the property located at One Old Farm House Road, Elkton,
