## **PUBLIC COMMENT/QUESTIONS**

Mario Gangemi talked about the 1 to 2 million in revenue generated through AA County Parks and Recreation and 501c3 he will be heading up.

Executive Moore asked about the market and if it was saturated or if there was room for growth. In Ms. Joseph's opinion, there is definitely room for growth with current sports and new and up and coming sports.

Councilman McCarthy asked about usage of synthetic turf fields and soil characteristics for the fields. The fields could be used 12 months a year, with not much of an influence for soil and a life expectancy of about 10 years before resurfacing.

Executive Moore asked about the political aspect with synthetic turf fields at a high school level. It was mentioned that there should not be a lot of opposition as high schools only have a limited capacity for holding tournaments. Multiple fields are needed in a close proximity for successful tournaments.

Chairman Harmer discussed the Economic Impact of hotels, casinos and the businesses in the area that are already asking to be involved as they see the potential with tournaments, festivals and extreme sports.
