RESOLUTION NO. 37-2014 (AS AMENDED)

Title of Resolution: Charter Amendment – Adoption of the Budget - Deadline

Synopsis: A Resolution amending Article 5, Budget and Finance, Section 507(b), Action on the Budget by Council, of the Cecil County Charter to provide that the adoption of the Budget shall be by the affirmative vote of not less than three members of the Council in a law enacted not later than the third Tuesday in June, instead of not later than May 31, and to require submission of this amendment to the legally qualified voters of Cecil County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with Section 602 of the Charter of Cecil County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter, the Charter may be amended by the procedures provided in Article XI-A of the Maryland Constitution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, amendments to any charter adopted by any County of this State under the provisions of this Article may be proposed by a resolution of the Council of the County, or by a petition signed by not less than 20% of the registered voters of the City or County, provided, however, that in any case 10,000 signatures shall be sufficient to complete a petition; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election Law Article, the County Attorney shall prepare and certify to the appropriate local board, not later than the third Monday in August, the following information as required under §7-103(c) of the Election Law Article for each question to be voted on in the County: (1) a question number or letter as by the Election Board; (2) a brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3) a brief descriptive title in boldface type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the question; and (5) the voting choices that the voter has; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the President of the County Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in at least one newspaper published in said County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, an amendment so proposed shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election occurring after the passage of the resolution; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for and against the amendment shall be in favor thereof, the amendment shall be adopted and become a part of the charter of the County from and after the thirtieth day after said election; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Budget and Finance, Section 507(b), Action on the Budget by Council, of the Cecil County Charter currently provides that, "The adoption of the Budget shall

be by the affirmative vote of not less than three members of the Council in a law enacted not later than May 31, which shall be known as the "Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance of Cecil County"; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, this Resolution proposes the following amendment to Article 5, Budget and Finance, Section 507(b), Action on the Budget by Council, of the Cecil County Charter: "The adoption of the Budget shall be by the affirmative vote of not less than three members of the Council in a law enacted not later than the third Tuesday in June, which shall be known as the "Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance of Cecil County." IF A BUDGET IS NOT APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL BY THE THIRD TUESDAY IN JUNE, THEN THE BUDGET AS SUBMITTED BY THE EXECUTIVE SHALL BECOME LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County that the following amendment to Article 5, Budget and Finance, Section 507(b), Action on the Budget by Council, of the Cecil County Charter, shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the next general or congressional election in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution: "The adoption of the Budget shall be by the affirmative vote of not less than three members of the Council in a law enacted not later than the third Tuesday in June, which shall be known as the "Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance of Cecil County.";

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County that, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., §7-103(c)(3)(i) of the Election Law Article, the County Attorney shall prepare and certify to the appropriate local board, not later than the third Monday in August, 2014, the following information as required under §7-103(c) of the Election Law Article: (1) a question number or letter as by the Election Board; (2) a brief designation of the type or source of the question; (3) a brief descriptive title in boldface type; (4) a condensed statement of the purpose of the question; and (5) the voting choices that the voter has;

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County, that pursuant to Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, the amendments shall be published by the President of the County

Council once a week for five successive weeks prior to the election in at least one newspaper published in said County;

AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County, that in accordance with Article 6, Section 602 of the Cecil County Charter and Article XI-A, §5 of the Maryland Constitution, if at the election the majority of the votes cast for and against the aforementioned proposed amendment shall be in favor thereof, then the proposed amendment shall be adopted and become a part of the Charter of Cecil County from and after the thirtieth day after said election.
