

COUNCIL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

2-6. Cancellation and adjournment of meetings

a) Scheduled meetings of the Council may be cancelled by the Council President or the Council. The Council President may cancel a scheduled meeting due to inclement weather. The Council may cancel a scheduled meeting by an affirmative vote of at least four (4) members, provided that the vote is taken at least seven (7) calendar days before the canceled meeting. Should a scheduled meeting be cancelled, any public hearings that may have been scheduled for that meeting shall be rescheduled.

b) If business cannot be concluded at the meeting in which it is scheduled for discussion, the Council may adjourn the proceedings to a later date, except business not concluded on a Legislative Day must be rescheduled on another Legislative Day, as per Chapter 2-1 (a).
