COUNCIL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

2-6. Cancellation and adjournment of meetings

- a) Scheduled meetings of the Council may be cancelled by the Council President or the Council. The Council President may cancel a scheduled meeting due to inclement weather. The Council may cancel a scheduled meeting by an affirmative vote of at least four (4) members, provided that the vote is taken at least seven (7) calendar days before the canceled meeting. Should a scheduled meeting be cancelled, any public hearings that may have been scheduled for that meeting shall be rescheduled.
- b) If business cannot be concluded at the meeting in which it is scheduled for discussion, the Council may adjourn the proceedings to a later date, except business not concluded on a Legislative Day must be rescheduled on another Legislative Day, as per Chapter 2-1 (a).
