15	WHEREAS, this program will award tax credits to non-profit organizations that they can use as an		
L6	incentive to encourage donations from Maryland businesses and individuals; and		
L7	WHEREAS, businesses and individual who donate to this project can earn tax credits equal to 50%		
L8	of the value of the donation, which is in addition to the deductions on both federal and state taxes as
