WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2015, the County 1 2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2016; and 3 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2016; and WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 2, 2015, the 5 6 County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2016; and 7 WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2016 Capital Budget to increase the bond 8 revenue and expenditure authority for Cecil County, Maryland to in order create a project known as 9 "Acquire 107 Chesapeake Boulevard, Elkton, Maryland"; and WHEREAS, through the efforts of staff to determine cost effective solutions to provide financial 10 savings for the exiting rented facility, an opportunity has been presented to acquire the entire facility and 11 WHEREAS, the acquisition of said facility is estimated to provide approximately \$7,100,000 in 12 savings over the next 20 years, and also provides a long-term commitment by the County to the Law 13 Enforcement and Emergency Services agencies currently housed at the location; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the County believes that a Property Management Enterprise Fund is necessary and efficient to manage the facility and to provide services; and 16 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide budget authority of \$7,300,000 to 17 accommodate the acquisition of the property, provide for estimated closing costs, and to provide funding 18 to fit-out approximately 3,038 square feet for an immediate law enforcement need; 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that 20 the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2016 is hereby 21 22 amended to increase bond budget authority within the Approved General Fund Capital Improvement Program budget by \$7,300,000 in order to purchase the property known as 107 Chesapeake Boulevard, 23 Elkton, Maryland, for the purpose of providing financial savings versus the existing rental arrangement, and 24 to create the Property Management Enterprise Fund to account for this economic activity. 25 AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date it 26 27 becomes law.
