**Title of Bill:** Bond Authority - Wastewater Capital Budget - Principio Sanitary Sewer-North and Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plan Project

**Synopsis:** A bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 in order to increase bond budget authority within the Wastewater Capital Budget by a total of \$1,400,000 in order to complete the Construct Principio Sanitary Sewer – North Project – 55018 (\$200,000) and to initiate the Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plant Project – 55069 (\$1,200,000).

Bond Authority - Wastewater Capital Budget -

Principio Sanitary Sewer North and Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plant Project

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2015, the County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2016; and WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2015; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 2, 2015, the County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2016 Capital Budget to increase the bond revenue and expenditure authority for Cecil County, Maryland for two capital projects in the total amount of \$1,400,000 as follows:

a) Construct Principio Sanitary Sewer – North - \$200,000; and

b) Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plant - \$1,200,000.

WHEREAS, the Principio Sanitary Sewer – North project requires additional funding due to costs associated to remedy recently discovered design errors, unforeseen underground site conditions, resulting in claims that are in dispute between the Contractor and the County, and to gain funding to secure the site following ongoing contractual negotiations, and

WHEREAS, the Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plant project was originally budgeted at \$1,200,000, and DPW has recommended that for a variety of reasons, the estimated projected cost should be \$2,400,000, as the original estimate was for 60,000 GPD whereby the quote should have reflected an estimated flow of 100,000 GPD, thereby creating the need for additional funding to move forward to bidding the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2016 is hereby amended to increase bond budget authority within the Wastewater Capital Budget by a total of \$1,400,000 in order to complete the Construct Principio Sanitary Sewer – North Project – 55018 (\$200,000) and to initiate the Mobile Package Waste Water Treatment Plant Project – 55069 (\$1,200,000).

**AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date it becomes law.
