Title of Bill: Bond Authority - Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program - Red Toad Road/Route 40 Intersection and Reservoir Road Culverts

Synopsis: A bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 in order to increase bond budget authority within the Approved General Fund Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program budget by a total of \$720,000 in order to complete the Red Toad Road at Route 40 Intersection Improvements Project – 52684 (\$325,000) and the Replace Reservoir Road Culverts Project – 52685 (\$395,000).

Bond Authority - Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Budget Red Toad Road/Route 40 Intersection - Reservoir Road Culverts

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2015, the County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 2, 2015, the County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2016 Capital Budget to increase the bond revenue and expenditure authority for Cecil County, Maryland to revise revenue and expense estimates for two Road and Bridge projects as follows:

- a) \$325,000 for the Red Toad Road at Route 40 Intersection Improvements Project 52684; and
- b) \$395,000 for the Replace Reservoir Road Culverts Project 52685.

WHEREAS, the Red Toad Road at Route 40 Intersection Improvement Project is comprised of adding a dedicated right turn lane from westbound Route 40 onto northbound Red Toad Road, and as the project is in final design, it has been determined by DPW that the initial cost estimates for the project are insufficient to provide an adequate contingency nor construction inspection services in the current bidding environment; and

WHEREAS, the Replace Reservoir Road Culverts Project is comprised of two culvert structures and the project was advertised and bid in mid-2015 which resulted in one bid receipt, which exceeded the initial cost estimate, and the determination was made to proceed with the easternmost structure, and upon evaluation, it has been determined by DPW that the additional funds requested will provide for an adequate contingency and construction inspection services in the current bidding environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2016 is hereby amended to increase bond budget authority within the Approved General Fund Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program budget by \$720,000 in order to complete the Red Toad Road at Route 40 Intersection Improvements Project-52684 (\$325,000) and the Replace Reservoir Road Culverts Project-52685 (\$395.000).

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date it becomes law.
